Summary

Console holder for curtains. The picture displays the printed part in grey (PETG) with the original part. Fits for ~13mm tube, my tube measures 12.8mm.

The holder can be taped by strong double side tape directly to a plastic frame of window (this is the original purpose) but it can be also screwed to a wall or a wooden material by 3mm diameter screws.
